

Definition

- Suspension means that a student is precluded from attending school and school activities for a specified period of time. Suspension in these procedures may include internal withdrawal of students from class, in exceptional circumstances withdrawal from the College
- Expulsion means that the school terminates its contractual obligations to educate a particular student and the student's enrolment is concluded.

Rationale

It is the expectation that all students and staff can attend and work in a safe and secure environment. Student responsibilities are emphasised to create this environment.
